1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Chair Olson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. Approval of the Board of Public Works Minutes of August 25, 2020

Motion by Gloria Teifke, second by Tr. Heckendorf to approve the Board of Public Works minutes of August 25, 2020.

3. Change Order #2 – Spruce Street & Ridgeway Drive Extension Project

Brian Kober explained the change order line items additions and a credit for water main blow-offs.

Motion by Tr. Heckendorf, second by Tr. Lippold to recommend Budget & Finance and Village Board approve Change Order #2 – Spruce Street & Ridgeway Drive Extension Project not to exceed \$17,584.00.

4. Pay Request #3 – Spruce Street & Ridgeway Drive Extension Project

Brian Kober stated the project has been stoned and the curbing installation is next.

Village owned streetlights will be added in a few weeks.

Motion by Chair Olson, second by Tr. Lippold to recommend Budget & Finance and Village Board approve Pay Request #3 – Spruce Street & Ridgeway Drive Extension in the amount of \$136,129.35.

5. Pay Request #1 – 2020 Road and Utility Project (Hunters Road)

Brian Kober commented they are prepping the road and next they will start pouring concrete curbing. All the underground utility has been finished.

Motion by Chair Olson, second by Tr. Heckendorf to recommend Budget & Finance and Village Board approve Pay Request #1 – 2020 Road and Utility Project (Hunters Road) in the amount of \$103,779.81.

6. Review of Quotes for 2020 Jackson Water Utility Service Truck

Brian Kober gave information on the 2019 the truck that was ordered but not received. This Spring a truck was ordered which should be delivered next month. Orders are now being taken for trucks that will be received next year. This is a budgeted item for next year. If ordered this year, the truck is guaranteed to be delivered next year.

Motion by Tr. Heckendorf, second by Tr. Lippold to recommend Budget & Finance and Village Board approve the purchase of the 2020 Jackson Water Utility Service Truck from Ewald Automotive Group in the amount of \$26,653.00.

7. 2021 – Five (5) Year Capital Improvements Program

Brian Kober presented the 2021 Five (5) Year Capital Improvements Program. The TIF projects were explained. Coffeerville Path, we were not selected for the grant funds. Discussion ensued on sidewalks and future projects.

Brian Kober presented the 2021 Public Works Equipment Program. Discussion included taking over plowing for Town roads coming into the Village in 2021 and purchasing a plow truck.

9. 2021 Budget Presentation – Public Works, Water & Wastewater Utilities

Brian Kober presented the 2021 Public Works, Water & Wastewater Utilities Budget. He reported on the Public Works budget is increasing \$58,877.00 and a 1.4% increase for Water & Wastewater Utilities.

Brian Kober hasn't heard back from the Department of Transportation on the signs. We have an opportunity to change streetlights along Highway 60 prior to the 2024 resurfacing project.

The Village Hall Generator stop working in September of 2020, we have been looking at options to find a replacement that matches the same setup that we have presently. Charles Equipment Energy Systems has been actively searching for a replacement.

The proposed 1998 Ford Engine 40kw Olympian natural gas generator has 532 hours of usage on the unit. The total cost of the unit and installation would be \$17,600.00. The unit would fit in the current enclosure and work with the existing transfer switch.

The purchase would be done by the Jackson Water Utility and the generator would be relocated to the Jackson Water Utility/Street Department Building after moving the Village Hall and Police Department in September of 2021.

2. Open breakers for battery charger and block heaters.
3. Remove remote start wires.
4. Drain oil and antifreeze.
5. Disconnect natural gas supply line.
6. Disconnect electrical connections to generator end junction box.
7. Remove unit from existing pad.
8. Remove unit from existing enclosure.
9. Supply a "USED"
10. Mount "USED" unit into original enclosure.
11. Mount package back onto original pad.
12. Supply labor and material to reconnect natural gas feed.
13. Supply labor and material to reconnect all electrical connections.
14. Close battery charger and block heater breakers.
15. Perform start up services using load bank for 1 hour.
16. Reconnect remote start wires.
17. Perform transfer test with building load.
18. Release unit for beneficial use.

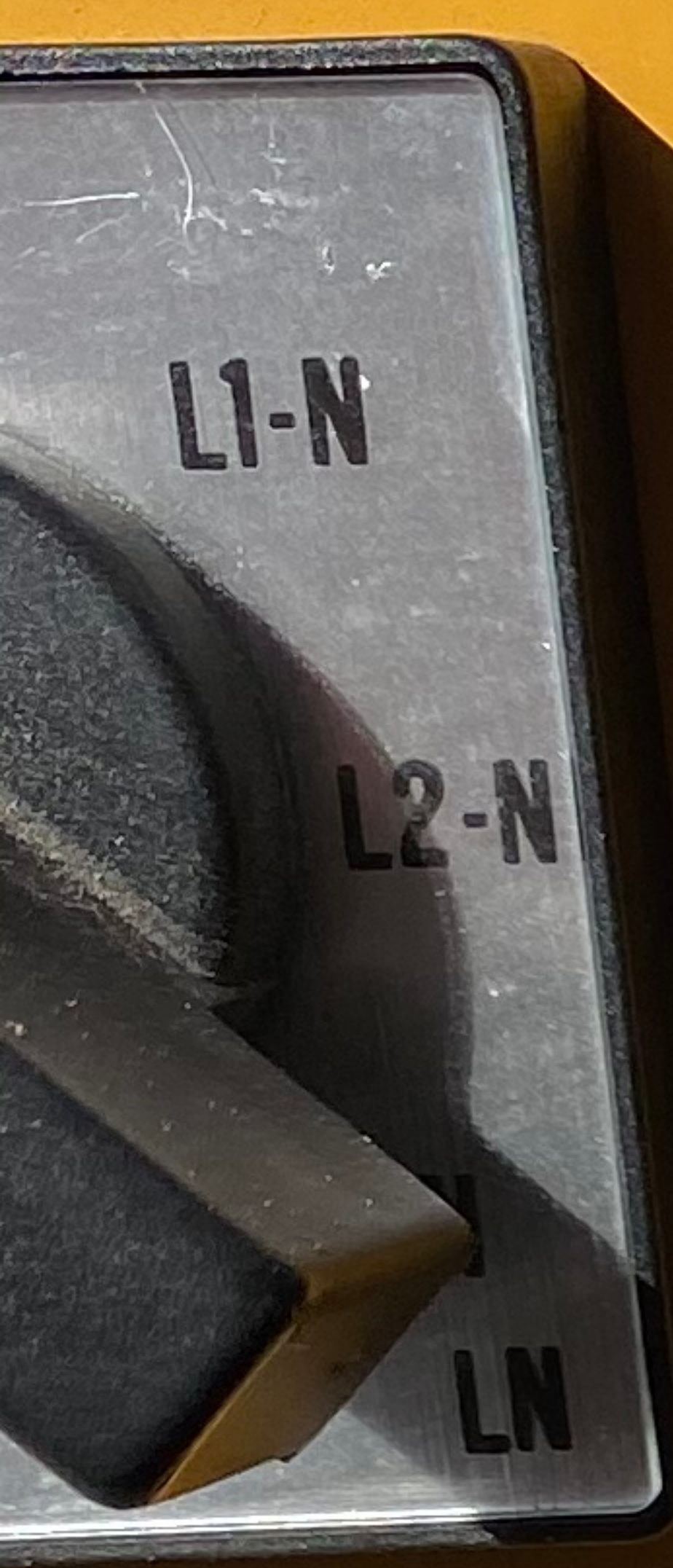
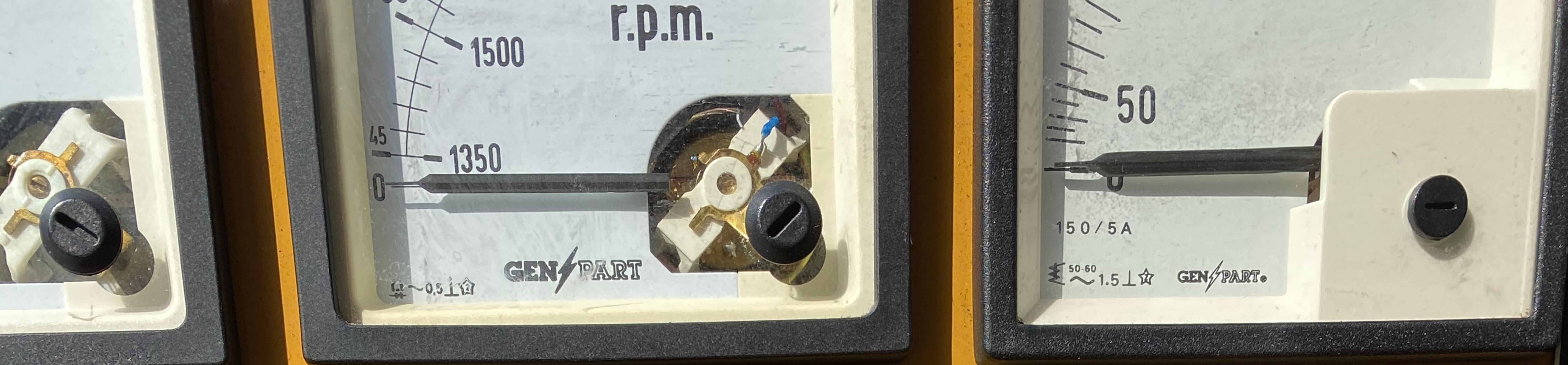

Per the 2020 Five Year Public Works Capital Equipment Report, and \$70,000.00 was set aside in the Capital Expenditures Fund to purchase a One Ton Plow Truck to replace the 2000 One Ton Chipper Truck. The 2005 One Ton Truck would become the new chipper truck.

Phone calls were made to local dealerships and the low quote came from Ewald Automotive Group for a purchase price of \$29,500.00. The Jackson Water Utility just received the same truck from EVS for a price of \$29,783.80. The proposed truck has a savings of \$283.80 compared to the early 2020 truck order.

The stainless box, hitch, trailer wiring, lighting, and plow quote came from a locate business of Jackson Truck Body Inc for a cost of \$22,451.00.

The total cost of the One Ton Truck is \$51,951.00

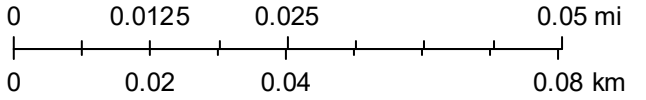
