Stat. § 19.85(1)(g) for the purpose of conferring with legal counsel for the Board who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the Board with respect to litigation in which the Board is or is likely to become involved. The purpose of the closed session will be to discuss aspects of the Petition that qualify for closed session discussion under the above-stated exemptions (Roll call vote required).
